
## Problem 2

The robotic arm from the previous problem is in the configuration shown below. Assume that theta is currently 30 degrees and that point C currently lies along the x axis. If we want the end effector at C to travel 1 ft/s in the negative x direction, what should the angular velocities be at joints A and B?



$$X_{c}(t) = -3_{sin}(\theta)\dot{\theta} - 2_{sin}(\phi)\dot{\phi} = -1_{fr,s}$$

$$-1.5\dot{\theta} - 1.5\dot{\phi} = -1$$

$$0 = -0 + .667$$

$$Y_{c}(t) = 3_{cos}(\theta)\dot{\theta} - 2_{cos}(\phi)\dot{\phi} = 0_{str,s}$$

$$2.598\dot{\theta} - 1.3228 = 0$$

$$.5092 \dot{\phi} = -\dot{\phi} + .667$$

$$|.5092 \dot{\phi} = .667 \longrightarrow |\dot{\phi} = .442 \text{ rad}_{/s}$$

$$\dot{\phi} = -\dot{\phi} + .667 \longrightarrow |\dot{\phi} = .225 \text{ rad}_{/s}$$
